STIPENDIARY STEWARDS' REPORT

Report on Race Meeting held at Morphettville Parks Racecourse
by the South Australian Jockey Club on Saturday, 1 August 2020

TRACK: Good 4 (Track with some give in it)

RAIL: Out 3 metres 1000 metres to the winning post, true remainder - sectional 604 metres

WEATHER: Fine

RACE 1: FURPHY THREE-YEARS-OLD MAIDEN PLATE - 1000 Metres

CALL ME ARCHER (R. Hurdle) - awkward to begin.

JAKAZONE (S. Fawke) - over-raced in the early stages of the event and approaching the 800 metres rolled out and became awkward inside the heels of **ORDER IS RESTORED** for a number of strides. A post-race veterinary examination revealed no visible abnormalities.

SUPER LOOKA (T. Voorham) - a post-race veterinary examination revealed a minor laceration to the left side of its mouth.

ULTIMATE VICTORY (D. Tourneur) - very awkward and slow to begin. Over-raced in the early stages of the event and near the 700 metres when racing outside the heels of **GOGOLF GURU** and inside **JAKAZONE**, became awkwardly placed between these two runners for a number of strides. Laid in, in the straight. A post-race veterinary examination revealed no visible abnormalities.

GOGOLF GURU (J. Holder) - very awkward to begin.

RACE 2: TAB MAIDEN PLATE - 1250 Metres

DIVINE SUCCESS (S. Logan) - awkward and slow to begin.

MONRAAJ (D. Tourneur) - inclined to lay out in the straight.

PLYMPTON (J. Holder) - awkward to begin. Was held up for clear running from in the vicinity of the 500 metres until near the 400 metres.

CALL ME WENDALL (K. Zechner) - raced keenly in the early stages of the event.

THE OLYMPIAN (B. Vorster) - shifted in under pressure prior to the finish and hampered **PASSING PHASE**, which was obliged to be steadied. Rider was reminded of his obligations when his mounts commence to shift ground.

PASSING PHASE (A. Jordsjo) - prior to the finish was tightened between **PROMOTER**, which maintained its line, and **THE OLYMPIAN** which shifted in under pressure and as a consequence, had to be steadied for a number of strides.

RACE 3: CHALK HILL HANDICAP - 1000 Metres

IRISH MINT (C. Jones) - awkward to begin. Over-raced in the early stages of the event.

CELTIC BLAST (R. Hurdle) - raced keenly and wide without cover in the early stages of the event.

BRIMARVI VEHERO (D. Tourneur) - was held up for clear running from near the entrance to the straight until near the 300 metres.

HARD ROCK GIRL (B. Vorster) - over-raced in the early stages of the event. Shifted out under riding from in the vicinity of the 200 metres and hampered **STAR OF MONSOON**, which was obliged to be steadied, and was unable to obtain clear running for some distance until near the 50 metres as a consequence. Rider was severely reprimanded and advised to take greater care when his mounts commence to shift ground. A post-race veterinary examination revealed no visible abnormalities.

STAR OF MONSOON (S. Logan) - raced keenly in the early stages of the event. Had to be steadied and became held up for clear running from inside the 200 metres when attempting to improve into a run between **IRISH MINT** and **HARD ROCK GIRL** as **HARD ROCK GIRL** shifted out under riding, and as a consequence was obliged to shift out near the 50 metres to obtain clear running.

ATOMIC LOKADE (K. Crowther) - slow to begin.

RACE 4: GRAHAM BURNS MEMORIAL HANDICAP - 2250 Metres

OURKHANI (C. Jones) - awkward to begin, shifted out and contacted **REX GOLIATH**. Shortly after the start, raced in restricted room for a number of strides between **REX GOLIATH** and **CHARLTON**. Was held up for clear running from approaching the entrance to the straight when racing inside **FORAOISE** and behind **DISCO REBEL** and was only able to obtain clear running from in the vicinity of the 200 metres.

DISCO REBEL (K. Crowther) - a post-race veterinary examination revealed the mare to be lame in both forelegs. Co-Trainer Mr J. Dunn was advised a Veterinary Certificate of Fitness would be required prior to presenting the horse for a future trial or race.

VINACEOUS (NZ) (T. Pannell) - inside the 1600 metres, when racing keenly, got its head up on two occasions and raced very ungenerously for a short distance. Thereafter, near the 1000 metres owing to the pace in the event, again got its head up and raced ungenerously for a number of strides.

REX GOLIATH (J. Toeroek) - contacted at the start.

KARAOKE EXPRESS (S. Logan) - raced keenly in the early stages of the event. Near the 1600 metres took an awkward stride. When questioned, rider explained her mount became awkward in its action when following **VINACEOUS (NZ)** near the 1600 metres as that horse became ungenerous and contacted the running rail. She stated her mount reacted to the running rail being contacted by **VINACEOUS (NZ)**.

FORAOISE (A. Jordsjo) - approaching the 1000 metres, when the pace slackened, became awkward on the heels of **OURKHANI** for a number of strides and thereafter, from in the vicinity of the 900 metres, raced wide without cover.

RACE 5: CAMP QUALITY HANDICAP - 1250 Metres

THIS KID ROCKS (B. Vorster) - was held up for clear running from near the 300 metres until in the vicinity of the 200 metres and was then able to commence to improve its position for a short distance however, again became held up for clear running approaching the 100 metres, when racing to the inside of **CALL ME CURTIS** as that horse momentarily shifted in. As a consequence

RACE 5: CAMP QUALITY HANDICAP - 1250 Metres (Cont'd)

THIS KID ROCKS was obliged to shift to the inside of BEEOKAY in an attempt to obtain clear running, however, from near the 100 metres, was unable to improve to that horse's inside and was obliged to race in restricted room to the inside of that horse's heels and to the outside of RED DYNAMO (NZ). As a consequence was untested to the line.

OH MO - underwent a pre-race veterinary examination on arrival at the barriers and was found to be lame in the near foreleg. Acting on this advice, Stewards withdrew the gelding at 2.49 pm. Trainer Mr S. Burford was advised a Veterinary Certificate of Fitness would be required prior to presenting the gelding for a future trial or race.

DANGER DEAL (J. Holder) - rider reported the horse felt short in its near foreleg on pulling up. A post-race veterinary examination revealed the gelding to be lame in the near foreleg. Co-Trainer Mr L. Macdonald was advised a Veterinary Certificate of Fitness would be required prior to presenting the gelding for a future trial or race.

PERFECT COMMAND (C. Jones) - was held up for clear running from near the entrance to the straight until approaching the 200 metres when racing behind CALL ME CURTIS and as a consequence was obliged to shift out to gain clear running.

BEEOKAY (K. Crowther) - a post-race veterinary examination revealed no visible abnormalities.

CALL ME CURTIS (T. Voorham) - raced wide without cover in the early and middle stages of the event. Near the 100 metres momentarily shifted in and inconvenienced THIS KID ROCKS.

RACE 6: JOCKEY CELEBRATION DAY HANDICAP - 1400 Metres

LEFT HAND MAN (S. Logan) - taken wider near the entrance to the straight by CANNOT BE SERIOS (NZ) which shifted out. When questioned regarding her instructions, S. Logan explained that Trainer Mr O'Connor instructed her to allow the gelding to jump freely, however, to attempt to obtain cover from the wide barrier. She added that after beginning positively, she elected to restrain her mount to obtain cover and managed to find cover, however settled further back than intended. Mr O'Connor confirmed the instructions provided to S. Logan. When questioned regarding the instructions provided in respect of this horse's previous starts he stated that he had been non-specific and left his riders with a degree of flexibility and to allow them to make an assessment of the pace and formation of the field. He added that the gelding does have a tendency to settle in a forward position, generally, of its own accord, particularly when drawing more favourable barriers. Stewards noted that in his post-race interview Mr O'Connor, when questioned as to whether he had instructed his rider to settle back in today's event, answered in the affirmative. Mr O'Connor stated that his answer was general in terms and what was intended was to attempt to obtain cover in the event. He added that he also did not intend for the gelding to settle as far back in running as it did. While Stewards were satisfied that Mr O'Connor's actions did not breach the provisions of AR 100 - the rule dealing with notification of a change in riding instructions, his attention was drawn to the provisions of that rule.

GOING GAGA (A. Jordsjo) - raced keenly and wide without cover from near the 1000 metres and was taken wider near the entrance to the straight by LEFT HAND MAN as that horse shifted out and away from CANNOT BE SERIOS (NZ), which shifted out.

RIKIBOBBY (T. Pannell) - was held up for clear running from near the 300 metres until near the 200 metres. A post-race veterinary examination revealed no visible abnormalities.

CANNOT BE SERIOS (NZ) (S. Fawke) - shifted out near the entrance to the straight taking LEFT HAND MAN wider.

GALCRUM (J. Maund) - rider reported that the mare never travelled during the event and felt awkward in its action on pulling up. A post-race veterinary examination revealed the mare to be lame in the near hind leg. Trainer, Mr D. Reynolds, was advised that a Veterinary Certificate of Fitness was required prior to a future trial or race start.

RACE 6: JOCKEY CELEBRATION DAY HANDICAP - 1400 Metres (Cont.)

BELLA AMORE (K. Crowther) - A post-race veterinary examination revealed no visible abnormalities.

RACE 7: ADELAIDE GALVANISING HANDICAP - 1550 Metres

TERRITORY TITAN (C. Jones) - shifted out shortly after the start. Near the 800 metres shifted in and inconvenienced BARRYMORE for a number of strides. Rider was reminded of her obligations when shifting ground.

TUBBY TWO TRACKS (D. Caboche) - inclined to lay in, in the straight.

BARRYMORE (T. Voorham) - near the 800 metres became awkwardly placed and was inconvenienced when racing inside the heels of TERRITORY TITAN, which shifted in.

TABERNA (S. Logan) - a post-race veterinary examination revealed no visible abnormalities.

NEAR MAGIC (S. Fawke) - shortly after the start, was awkwardly placed on the heels of TERRITORY TITAN for a number of strides as that horse shifted out. A post-race veterinary examination revealed no visible abnormalities.

RACE 8: TERRY HOWE PRINTING HANDICAP - 1300 Metres

STRYKE IN STYLE (J. Toeroek) - near the 700 metres raced in restricted room inside WOUNDED SOLDIER (NZ) for a short distance, as that horse shifted in slightly. Was held up for clear running for a short distance inside the 500 metres.

WOUNDED SOLDIER (NZ) (B. Vorster) - shifted in slightly near the 700 metres.

LEORBIT (S. Cahill) - near the 300 metres shifted out slightly and hampered PALE ALE. Rider reminded of his obligations when shifting ground.

JIVE BABY (K. Crowther) - awkward and slow to begin. A post-race veterinary examination revealed no visible abnormalities.

MUSICAL QUERY (R. Hurdle) - over-raced in the early stages of the event. Raced wide without cover throughout the event. In the vicinity of the 300 metres shifted in slightly and hampered PALE ALE. Rider reminded of his obligations when shifting ground.

PALE ALE (T. Voorham) - contacted at the start. Over-raced in the early and middle stages of the event. Approaching the 300 metres, attempted to improve into a tight run between MUSICAL QUERY and LEORBIT, which both shifted ground slightly and as a consequence was obliged to be checked for several strides and was unable to improve its position, until in the vicinity of the 200 metres. As a further consequence of this incident, ORLEANS was momentarily inconvenienced when racing behind MUSICAL QUERY. A post-race veterinary examination revealed minor lacerations to the off hind coronet.

TEXAS LIL (K. Zechner) - underwent a pre-race veterinary examination prior to the event and was passed fit to race. Awkward to begin, shifted in and contacted PALE ALE.

ORLEANS (E. Boyd) - momentarily inconvenienced near the 300 metres when awkward on the heels of MUSICAL QUERY.

GENERAL

Following the running of Race 5, Stewards opened an inquiry into an alleged incident involving Apprentice Jockey's A. Jordsjo and C. Jones in the jockey's room. After considering the evidence C. Jones was charged under AR115(1)(a), the particulars being that after the running of Race 5 and in the Jockey's Room, she misconducted herself by addressing A. Jordsjo in an inappropriate manner by directing foul language towards her. C. Jones pleaded guilty to the charge and having regard for her guilty plea, her clean record and other factors, imposed a penalty of a fine of \$500 of which \$250 was suspended for a period of 12 months on the proviso that C. Jones does not reoffend under any misconduct rule during that period.
