Report on Race Meeting held at Morphettville Parks Racecourse
by the South Australian Jockey Club on Wednesday, 25 November 2020

TRACK: Good 4 (Track with some give in it)
Upgraded to a Good 3 at 3.53 pm retrospective to Race 7
(Track with good grass coverage and cushion)

RAIL: Out 6 metres entire. Sectional 608 metres.

RACE 1: HOLDFAST INSURANCE HANDICAP - 1550 Metres

SUPERVELOCE (NZ) (C. Lions) - laid out under pressure in the straight.

RACE 2: PETER ELBERG FUNERALS HANDICAP - 1250 Metres

SUPER STRIKER (T. Voorham) - a post-race veterinary examination revealed no visible abnormalities.

WINNING WEATHER (J. Holder) - shifted in, in the vicinity of the 900 metres onto **MONTEPULCIANO**. Rider was severely reprimanded for careless riding. Rider explained that it was not his intention to lead in this event; however, after jumping away well the filly took up the lead of its own accord without encouragement. Co-trainer, Mr L. Macdonald, confirmed that the instructions had not been to lead.

MONTEPULCIANO (P. Gatt) - jumped away awkwardly and shifted out contacting **WILD IMAGINATION (NZ)**. In the vicinity of the 900 metres had to be steadied for a number of strides when **WINNING WEATHER** shifted in.

BATTLE BLITZ (S. Logan) - in the vicinity of the 800 metres commenced to race keenly on the heels of **DANIYAH**, and shifted out resulting in the gelding racing wide without cover for the remainder of the event. Laid out under pressure rounding the home turn.

DANIYAH (B. Vorster) - slow to begin. Rider reported that the filly had not let down as he had anticipated when placed under pressure in the straight. A post-race veterinary examination revealed no visible abnormalities.

RACE 2: PETER ELBERG FUNERALS HANDICAP - 1250 Metres (Cont'd)

WILD IMAGINATION (NZ) (J. Toeroek) - hampered on jumping away when contacted by MONTEPULCIANO.

RACE 3: WESLO SECURITY MAIDEN PLATE - 1250 Metres

KIKUYU KING (R. Hurdle) - contacted on jumping away.

NONAME LANE (T. Pannell) - inclined to lay out under pressure in the straight.

OOLONG GAZE (S. Logan) - contacted in the vicinity of the 700 metres.

HELLO LADIES (P. Gatt) - raced keenly in the middle stages of the event and in the vicinity of the 700 metres rolled in and contacted OOLONG GAZE.

VANCOUVER VELVET (J. Holder) - rider explained that the gelding had not let down when placed under pressure in the straight and was disappointing. A post-race veterinary examination revealed no visible abnormalities.

KRUPTONITE (S. Fawke) - jumped away awkwardly and shifted out onto KIKUYU KING. Shortly after shifted back in abruptly losing ground.

SELLIX (J. Eaton) - inclined to lay out under pressure in the straight.

FREE OF SIN (D. Caboche) - raced keenly in the early and middle stages of the event.

RACE 4: FURPHY HANDICAP - 1300 Metres

LEFT HAND MAN (C. Jones) - approaching the 1000 metres shifted in slightly onto RENEGADE, which shifted in and away onto DON'TDREAMIT'SOVER (GB). Rider was reprimanded and advised in future to ensure she was sufficiently clear prior to commencing to shift ground.

RENEGADE (B. Vorster) - approaching the 1000 metres shifted in and away from LEFT HAND MAN onto DON'TDREAMIT'SOVER (GB). A post-race veterinary examination revealed no visible abnormalities.

TERRITORY TITAN (T. Voorham) - rider reported that she was instructed to take up a position on pace; however, the gelding was unable to obtain that position despite her efforts in the early stages of the event.

COSMIC AWARD (P. Gatt) - inclined to lay in under pressure in the straight.

DON'TDREAMIT'SOVER (GB) (J. Eaton) - approaching the 1000 metres had to be checked and lost its position when RENEGADE shifted in and away from LEFT HAND MAN.

RACE 5: WINNING EDGE PRESENTATIONS HANDICAP - 1300 Metres

The start of this event was delayed by approximately four minutes.

OH PLEASE DIANNA (B. Vorster) - contacted on jumping away.

LADY PERCY (J. Toeroek) - raced in restricted room over the concluding 100 metres when awkwardly placed between the heels of MAVETTE and RANGER CEE JAY.

RACE 5: WINNING EDGE PRESENTATIONS HANDICAP - 1300 Metres (Cont'd)

TIME WARRIOR (C. Jones) - shifted out on jumping away contacting OH PLEASE DIANNA. Raced keenly in the early and middle stages of the event. Rider pleaded guilty to a charge under AR132(7)(a)(ii) in that she used her whip on more than five occasions prior to the 100 metres and was reprimanded. In determining penalty Stewards had regard for the totality of the use of the whip by C. Jones and noted that she used her whip on six occasions over the final 100 metres of the event.

MAVETTE (S. Fawke) - got its leg up in its barrier after being loaded. Underwent a pre-race veterinary examination and was passed fit to start.

THE IRON LADY (J. Holder) - slow into stride.

SOWPODS (K. Crowther) - raced keenly in the middle stages of the event.

CALYPSO STORM (P. Gatt) - Stewards permitted P. Gatt to ride the mare 0.5 kg over its declared weight of 54.0 kg.

RACE 6: TAB CREATE YOUR SPRING CALENDAR OF PLAY HANDICAP - 1950 Metres

STAR STATUS (J. Holder) - laid out under pressure in the straight. A post-race veterinary examination revealed no visible abnormalities.

GETOUTTHEWAY (C. Jones) - raced keenly in the middle stages of the event. Approaching the 600 metres rolled in and contacted the running rail and became unbalanced momentarily. Rider reported that she had not been instructed to lead the event; however, due to there being no pace in the event the gelding found itself in front of its own accord.

COFFEE AMOUR (J. Eaton) - rider reported that the mare was disappointing and in her opinion had not handled the firm track condition. A post-race veterinary examination revealed no visible abnormalities.

FLORIANO (P. Gatt) - Stewards permitted P. Gatt to ride the mare 0.5 kg over its declared weight of 54.0 kg.

RACE 7: CHALK HILL HANDICAP - 1000 Metres

IRISH MINT (C. Jones) - was forced to race in restricted room momentarily in the vicinity of the 100 metres when AADELADE rolled out slightly at the same time as ARROW LANE shifted in slightly. A post-race veterinary examination revealed no visible abnormalities.

LI'L KONTRA (J. Holder) - rolled out slightly in the vicinity of the 700 metres onto SAORSA.

ARROW LANE (J. Maund) - shifted in slightly onto IRISH MINT approaching the 100 metres.

CALL IT A DAY (T. Pannell) - rider reported that the gelding put in some ordinary strides approaching the finish. A post-race veterinary examination revealed no visible abnormalities.

MAUDY (D. Caboche) - raced wide without cover throughout the event.

MYSTICANO (S. Logan) - slow to begin. Inside the 200 metres became awkwardly placed on the heels of PORT VALE for a number of strides.

PORT VALE (O. Ridge) - in the vicinity of the 200 metres improved onto the heels of IRISH MINT, which had commenced to weaken, and had to be momentarily steadied and alter course to obtain clear ground.

RACE 7: CHALK HILL HANDICAP - 1000 Metres (Cont'd)

SAORSA (K. Zechner) - had to be momentarily steadied in the vicinity of the 700 metres when LI'L KONTRA rolled out slightly. Had difficulty obtaining clear ground from the vicinity of the 300 metres until inside the 200 metres.

MRS HYDE (S. Fawke) - laid out under pressure in the straight.

RACE 8: TWILIGHT RACES AT MORPHETTVILLE - FRIDAY DEC 18 HANDICAP - 1550 Metres

GOING GAGA (S. Logan) - raced keenly in the early and middle stages of the event. Became held up from the entrance to the straight until the 200 metres.

MR STYLISH (J. Toeroek) - Mr T. Stokes, representing trainer Mr P. Stokes, advised Stewards prior to the event of a change of tactics in that he would instruct the rider to attempt to obtain a position on pace. Settled midfield.

CROWN HARMONIUM (S. Fawke) - refused to load. Stewards declared CROWN HARMONIUM a late scratching at 4.22 pm. Trainer, Mr J. Hickmott, was advised that the mare was now required to load without delay in an Official Barrier Trial prior to accepting for a future race.

EXALTED TRAVELLER (J. Holder) - inclined to lay in under pressure in the straight.

LEONARDA (C. Lions) - a post-race veterinary examination revealed no visible abnormalities.

RACE 9: ACCOLADE WINES HANDICAP - 1000 Metres

VIDUKA (C. Jones) - contacted by ANGASTON and inconvenienced when taken wider at the 100 metres.

BEERMINT (S. Fawke) - raced wide without cover throughout the event. A post-race veterinary examination revealed no visible abnormalities.

TINTAGEL ROCKER (E. Boyd) - slow into stride. Raced keenly in the early and middle stages of the event. Laid out under pressure in the straight. Rider reported that the gelding felt short in its action on pulling up. Rider explained that in the early stages of the straight she felt that the gelding would let down and improve onto the heels of RUBY'S REWARD and for this reason she elected to angle her mount out to the outside of the heels of VIDUKA prior to placing her mount under full pressure. She added that after obtaining clear running the horse had not responded as she had anticipated. A post-race veterinary examination revealed gelding to be lame in the near foreleg. Co-trainers, Mr J. Dunn and Miss K. Bishop, were advised that a Veterinary Certificate of Fitness was required prior to a future trial or race.

RUBY'S REWARD (T. Voorham) - in the vicinity of the 250 metres T. Voorham's whip was accidentally knocked out of her hand by the whip of C. Jones.

EXALTED ZOE (J. Holder) - jumped away awkwardly. Raced keenly in the early and middle stages of the event.

ANGASTON (K. Zechner) - inside the 100 metres shifted out to improve and in doing so brushed VIDUKA.
